



## PRESS NOTICE

1. The Mauritius High Commission invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders to submit their separate offers for the building renovation works of:
  - a. an apartment located in Earl's Court area, London (Procurement Reference No: OAB / MFA / MHCL / 2015 / 01)
  - b. semi-detached residence in Wimbledon area, London (Procurement Reference No: OAB / MFA / MHCL / 2015 / 02).

5. Electronic Bidding **shall not** be permitted. Late Bids will be rejected. The Bid Submission Box will be opened at the Mauritius High Commission at the address below on the same day at 14:00 hours in the presence of bidders/bidders' representatives who choose to attend
