COMMUNIQUE

Tsunami alerts on parts of Russia, Japan and neighbouring regions

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Regional Integration and International Trade of the Republic of Mauritius is monitoring the situation following the earthquake which hit the eastern coast of Russia in the Kamchatka Peninsula region today, 30 July 2025, and the subsequent tsunami alerts issued for parts of Russia, Japan, Alaska, Hawaii, China, Philippines, the US West Coast and the neighbouring regions.

The Ministry recommends all Mauritian nationals finding themselves in distress following the earthquake to proceed to safer zones away from the shores and to follow the advice of local authorities.
