

Position of Executive Director of the United Nations Entity for Gender Equality and the Empowerment of Women (UN Women)

Call for nominations

The United Nations (UN) Secretariat is inviting applications for the position of Executive Director of the United Nations Entity for Gender Equality and the Empowerment of Women (UN Women).

The Executive Director of UN Women is a member of the UN Secretary-General's Senior Management Group, at Under-Secretary-General level, and who is appointed by the UN Secretary-General, on the basis of equitable geographical representation and gender balance, for a term of four years. The Executive Director reports directly to the Secretary-General and is responsible for all the activities of UN Women, including its administration.

The nominee should demonstrate leadership qualities and extensive knowledge in the areas of gender equality, women empowerment, women's rights and in the achievement of the Sustainable Development Goals, amongst others. Additional information is contained in the attached Note.

Nomination for this position should be endorsed by the Government of Mauritius.
