Mauritius will be presenting the first Voluntary National Review (VNR) Report in July 2019 at the High Level Political Forum (HLPF) of the ECOSOC in New York.

The **Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Regional Integration and International Trade** (MFA) is leading in the preparation of the Mauritius VNR. The Report itself is a snapshot of how Mauritius is implementing the SDGs.
